Medical Stores Department as the strategic government store and the government agency in the Public Private Partnership (PPP) intends to establish General Pharmaceuticals Manufacturing Plant at Kibaha in Tanzania through PPP.

Tanzania through MSD imports over 90% of all her annual health commodity supplies requirements from overseas and it takes up to 6 months to complete the procurement cycle to get the commodities into the country.

By developing the domestic capacity in pharmaceuticals manufacturing Industry, the following impacts are expected;

- The country will reduce the excessive dependence on importation to less than 72%:
- The lead time to get the commodities will be cut down to within days;
- Quality assurance will be easily manageable internally by domestic regulatory agencies;
- New employment opportunities will be created in the manufacturing industry;
- Improvement of social services in proximity of the new manufacturing facility, e.g. access roads, power, etc.
